- Scissors
- Plastic 3 Prong Folders w/ pockets
- Binders

- Notebooks and Composition Notebooks
- Paper (Wide Ruled or College)
- Graphing Paper
- Calculator
- Hand Sanitizer
- Tissues
- Backpacks (must be clear or mesh)
- Earbuds
- Mask
